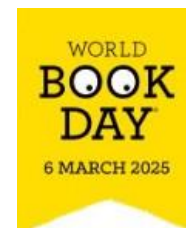

Dear Parents and Carers,

This year World Book Day is on Thursday 5th March. The School Council would like to celebrate World Book Day by inviting all of the children and staff to come to school dressed as their favourite book character. If the children have their favourite book we would like to invite them to bring it into school to share the blurb and to partake in 'hot seating' activities, where they are asked questions by their peers about the character they are dressed as.

We are hoping to be able to decorate each classroom door with photographs of the children dressed as their favourite character. In addition to the photographs we would love the children to draw their favourite character or do a piece of writing about their favourite book at home which they can bring in to school to be added to the door displays.

Due to the great success of a book swap in the past, we would welcome book donations from the children leading up to World Book Day and then on the day all children will be invited to select a different book from the donations.

The Travelling Books fayre will also be in school from Wednesday 4th March until 11th March. There will be opportunities for the children to browse the fayre during the school day and then come along after school with their adult, between 3:30 - 4:30pm to purchase their books should they wish to.
